I. CALL TO ORDER/ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Mrs. Moultrie called the Special Meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. Mrs. Moultrie noted that Mrs. Waters had advised that per Florida Statute, the items associated with the District's Tentative Facilities Work Program (Items VII and VIII) should be handled prior to the adoption of the millage rates and District School budget for fiscal year 2014-2015. On motion by Mr. Slayton, second by Mr. Bergosh, adoption of the agenda (as amended), carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR INPUT ON DISTRICT'S TENTATIVE FACILITIES WORK PROGRAM [Item VII]

Mrs. Moultrie called for public input on the District's tentative Facilities Work Program; however, there was no one who wished to speak.

ADOPTION OF DISTRICT'S TENTATIVE FACILTIES WORK PROGRAM [Item VIII]

Motion was made by Mrs. Hightower and seconded by Mr. Boone, to adopt the District's tentative Facilities Work Program. Motion carried unanimously.

II. PRESENTATION OF 2014-2015 MILLAGE RATES AND DISTRICT SCHOOL BUDGET

Mr. Terry St. Cyr, Assistant Superintendent for Finance & Business Services, gave a brief PowerPoint® presentation that outlined the budget and millage information for 2014-2015.

V. FINAL ADOPTION OF MILLAGE RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015

1. Required Local Effort

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Required Local Effort millage rate at 5.237 mills, carried unanimously.

2. Discretionary – Operating

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Discretionary – Operating millage rate at 0.748 mills, carried unanimously.

3. Local Capital Improvement (Capital Outlay)

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Local Capital Improvement (Capital Outlay) millage rate at 1.337 mills, carried unanimously.

4. Total Millage

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mr. Bergosh, to adopt the 2014-2015 Total Millage at 7.332 mills, carried unanimously.

VI. FINAL ADOPTION OF DISTRICT SCHOOL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015
1. General Fund

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mr. Slayton, to adopt the 2014-2015 General Fund budget in the amount of \$348,974,456.45, carried unanimously.

2. Special Revenue – Food Service

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mr. Bergosh, to adopt the 2014-2015 Special Revenue – Food Service budget in the amount of \$26,113,187.78, carried unanimously.

3. Special Revenue – Other

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Special Revenue – Other budget in the amount of \$40,016,652.83, carried unanimously.

4. Special Revenue – Race To The Top

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mr. Slayton, to adopt the 2014-2015 Special Revenue – Race To The Top budget in the amount of \$98,578.27, carried unanimously.

5. Debt Service Funds

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Debt Service Funds budget in the amount of \$10,963,060.43, carried unanimously.

6. Capital Project Funds

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mrs. Hightower, to adopt the 2014-2015 Capital Project Funds budget in the amount of \$135,776,884.53, carried unanimously.

7. Internal Service Funds

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mr. Slayton, to adopt the 2014-2015 Internal Service Funds budget in the amount of \$55,371,088.24, carried unanimously.

8. Total Budget

Motion by Mr. Boone, seconded by Mr. Bergosh, to adopt the 2014-2015 Total Budget in the amount of \$617,313,908.53, carried unanimously.
