#### 4. Total Millage

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mr. Fetsko, to adopt the 2020-2021 Total Millage rate at 5.928 mills, carried 4 to 1, with Mr. Adams voting "No."

# 7. Capital Project Funds

Motion by Mr. Fetsko, seconded by Mr. Slayton, to adopt the 2020-2021 Capital Project Funds budget in the amount of \$178,140,191.05, carried 4 to 1, with Mr. Adams voting "No."

#### 8. Internal Service Funds

Motion by Mr. Slayton, seconded by Mr. Adams, to adopt the 2020-2021 Internal Service Funds budget in the amount of \$64,329,665.60, carried unanimously.

# 9. Total Budget

Motion by Mr. Fetsko, seconded by Mr. Slayton, to adopt the 2020-2021 Total Budget in the amount of \$754,758,059.01, carried unanimously.
