There was much discussion regarding proposed changes to the interlocal agreement with the county as well as changes to the county's comprehensive plan, which would ensure more sidewalks are constructed and connected closer to schools. School Board Members expressed support for changing the interlocal agreement with the county to provide more connected sidewalks so students can walk to school more safely. There was interest in eventually holding a joint meeting with the Board of County Commissioners to request updates to the documents. Chair Slayton asked School Board Members to review all parts of the interlocal agreement; meanwhile, he and Superintendent Smith would look into holding another workshop on the issue to better prepare before approaching the county.
