- 27. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 10-221-221 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 28. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 10-222-221 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year and all of the 2010-2011 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 29. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 10-223-601 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year and all of the 2010-2011 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program

- exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 30. Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 10-224-601 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year and all of the 2010-2011 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.

Recommend that, consistent with the decision of the due process committee, student discipline number 10-228-221 be expelled from all public schools of Escambia County for the remainder of the 2009-2010 school year and all of the 2010-2011 school year with the option to enroll, if qualified and if space is available, in an alternative educational program exclusive of regular school placement. Placement to be at the discretion of the Superintendent and to be available as an alternative during the full expulsion time frame.
- 4. Recommend that employee #812466 be terminated effective July 21, 2010, pursuant to s. 1012.34, F.S.
- 5. Recommend that employee #13441 be suspended without pay beginning Wednesday, July 21, 2010, pending the outcome of the district investigation and disposition of criminal charges.
